Parcelas de Garnacha LURRALDE 2023

VINTAGE

Warm and dry vintage. The drought that began in 2022 carried over and intensified through the winter and spring of 2023. Despite adverse conditions and sparse, uneven vegetative growth, yields remained average. The harvest itself was exceptionally wet and warm, yet the rot problems so common in such years did not occur. Overall, the wines are concentrated, with a fresh-fruit profile and low pH.

GRAPE VARIETY

Red and Grey Grenache.

VINEYARD

Three old vine plots in different altitudes representing the traditional vineyards planted in bush in the village of San Martín de Unx. A total of 0.8 Has. Organic and hand-crafted viticulture.

WINE-MAKING

Hand Harvested, 1st September.

Yield: 3100 Kg/Ha.

Fermented in stainless steel tanks with indigenous yeasts and gentle daily pumping over. Half of the wine aged in used French oak barrels for 4 months. Unfined and unstabilized wine. No oenological products added. Only sulphur in moderate levels. Filtered before bottling in May 2023.

TASTING NOTES

A fine wine with a modern style, very light in color. Red fruits and orange peel aromas with pronounced herbal notes typical of the San Martín de Unx vineyard. Light and smooth on the palate, yet full of character.
